Dr. Ivan Ash is an Associate Professor of Psychology in the College of Sciences at Old Dominion University. He received his Ph.D. in Cognitive Psychology from the University of Illinois at Chicago. Dr. Ash joined ODU’s faculty in 2005, where he has taught courses in Statistics, Research Methods, and Human Cognition. He has received University teaching awards, and was the founding Director of ODU’s Undergraduate Research Program from 2010 to 2013. Dr. Ash’s research investigates the roles of automatic and controlled cognitive processes in learning, problem solving, creativity, judgment formation, and decision making. In addition, Dr. Ash has collaborated with interdisciplinary research teams to adapt information processing theories and psychological research methodologies to applied topics such as online/multimedia education, beliefs about climate change and sea level rise, age related cognitive decline, perceptual functioning in ADHD populations, seat-belt use, and cybersecurity behavior.
